

Greenfield Tennis Club Rules

Welcome to the Greenfield Tennis Club. This is a non-profit organization that is run by volunteers. Fees for this club pay for the coach and for the assistant. **Greenfield Community League** members are able to play at set times and must be supervised by either the coach or the assistant while playing. They must show their **Community League membership card** and sign in before being allowed to play. Paid members will always get **priority** on the courts. A membership will allow you to play on the courts at **any time**. The clubhouse can only be accessed when the coach or assistant are on duty. Membership is a **privilege** and not a right. Therefore, do **NOT** share the access codes. Take pride in your club. All members are **expected to volunteer** in some way.

- 1 – Appropriate footwear must be worn on the courts
- 2 – Appropriate attire is expected. Tops must be worn.
- 3 – No foul language.
- 4 – Shoe tags must be worn to show membership. If you don't have your shoe tag, you will be asked to leave.
- 5 – No pets are allowed on the court.
- 6 – No bikes, roller blades or skateboards on the court
- 7 – No food, glass or alcoholic beverages are allowed on the court.
- 8 – Limit play to one hour when other people are waiting to play.
- 9 – Play at your own risk.
- 10 – Dispose of garbage properly. Do **NOT** throw it on the court.
